Interested in DMR?

Digital Mobile Radio (DMR) is an open digital voice standard that I began looking into over the summer. While many Clubs have gone to Icom's D-STAR for digital voice, I believe DMR is a good option for those wanting to go digital while staying clear of vendor specific communications technologies.

DMR uses TDMA (time division multiple access), allowing for 2 simultaneous voice conversations on a single repeater. When the repeater is connected to a DMR network, it becomes possible to have crystal clear voice communications with others on the network, which can include other digital hams located around the world.

While most radios capable of DMR have been commercial grade from vendors like Motorola or Vertex, we are starting to see inexpensive

radios emerge from China. I found the Tytera MD-380 which can be purchased for less than \$300CA on eBay, and is capable of both digital and analog communication.

On the DMR-MARC Worldwide Network, you can see repeaters mostly clustered in Ontario (<http://www.dmr-marc.net/repeaters.html>), although there are others – notably Winnipeg (VE4SLK) and Edmonton (VE6VPR).

While analog radio is still near and dear to my heart, I can see a future in digital radio and believe DMR is the right road to travel.

Repeater News

The Stranraer repeater, VE5UB, has been moved to Watrous Sask. It will still be on 147.03 mHz + and will be using the callsign VE5UB. This fills the hole left when the previous Watrous repeater VE5IM on 146.7 mHz- was decommissioned.

Word is that the VE5DNA repeater near Humboldt on 147.21 mHz + will soon be back on the air with new equipment.

The Parkland Amateur radio group is working on linking all of their repeaters in that area. When completed, all repeaters on the system will be accessible through a single IRLP node.

RARA is looking into linking VE5YQR with VE5ARG at Avonlea.
